## Epistemological Canons in Language, Literature and Cultural Studies The 26<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference of the Polish Association for the Study of English Conference Report

The 26th Annual Conference of the Polish Association for the Study of English was organized by the Institute of English and American Studies of University of Gdańsk between 22<sup>nd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> June 2017. The main theme of the conference was 'Epistemological Canons in Language, Literature and Cultural Studies' and it attracted attention of nearly one hundred scholars from Poland and abroad. The theme of the conference was as usual only a pretext for a great number of scholarly responses and those we witnessed in Gdańsk were truly impressive in their variety. The papers were divided into panels in literature, theatre studies, linguistics, translation studies, cultural studies, film studies, to mention but a few. The participants were forced to choose between as many as five panels at a time. The conference also offered an opportunity for the members of the PASE to debate on the future plans of our Association during the annual general meeting. The plenary lectures were delivered by Professor Christoph Bode (Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität, München), Professor Marek Wilczyński (Gdańsk University), Professor Christina Schäffner (Aston University, Birmingham), and Professor Małgorzata Grzegorzewska (Warsaw University).
